



German Hausbarn Museum

Situated in DeWitt's Lincoln Park, the Hausbarn is home to the DeWitt Chamber & Development Company and a German Hausbarn museum. The building originates from Schleswig-Holstein, Germany, and was built in 1727.

In 2007, the building was dismantled and brought to DeWitt where it was reassembled in the 2008 with the help of many community volunteers. Tours are available 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday and by appointment on the weekend or after hours.

John Bloom

This DeWitt native was a renowned artist who painted, sketched, carved, and did creative lithographs in the Regionalist style. Bloom participated in Grant Wood's Stone City Art Colony of 1932-33, where he worked alongside his mentor.

Several of Bloom's original works are on display throughout the DeWitt community. "Shucking Corn," a mural painted in 1937-38, is in city hall. In "After Church," from 1934, Bloom depicts himself leaving St. Joseph Catholic Church as a young man. It is in the entryway of St.

Bloom's sketches, paintings, and sculptures are on display in the DeWitt Operahouse Theatre lobby and a section is dedicated to Bloom within the historical society as well. Two bronze statues created from scenes from Bloom's "Shucking Corn" mural are on the north and south ends of DeWitt's downtown district on 6th Avenue. We invite you to discover Bloom's artwork throughout our community.

Originally constructed in 1878, the DeWitt Operahouse Theatre was home to many vaudeville acts in its early days.

Now it is open year-round and offers box office movies, live entertainment, First Central Art Gallery exhibits, John Bloom original artwork, and the popular Noon Lions Travelogues.

Paul Skeffington Memorial Trail

This well-maintained trail is 10-feet wide and covers more than six miles. The paved trail is ideal for walking, running, and riding bikes. Much of the trail is through scenic wooded areas in addition to flowing into Westbrook Park. The trail is also part of the route during the very popular Paul Skeffington Memorial race held in June.


Westbrook Park

DeWitt's largest park at 100 acres, Westbrook is filled with numerous amenities, including picnic shelters, four baseball/softball diamonds, three playground equipment areas, pump track, Camp Minor Boy Scout Camp, an 18-hole disc golf course, an off-road mountain bike trail, a butterfly garden, a dog park, and an exercise course. The park also includes a natural timber area with foot trails and access to the Paul Skeffington Memorial Trail, a 10-foot wide multipurpose trail. The Skeffington Trail includes a Story Walk with 20 kiosks that feature the pages of a book. Stories are on display in the spring, summer, and fall. Silver Creek runs through the park.





eWitt has an extensive list of recreational opportunities. DeWitt's Parks & Recreation Department supplies a wide range of programs for children and adults, as well as offering many parks and outdoor activities. DeWitt takes great pride in the more than half dozen well-maintained parks. Enjoy vast amenities such as the 18-hole golf course, walking and bike trails, mountain bike trails, sports fields, a dog park, Skate Park, basketball courts, and plenty of outdoor green space.

Aquatic Center

The DeWitt Aquatic Center is the perfect place for a long summer day! You can hear splashing at the Aquatic Center from Memorial Day through Labor Day. This \$2.6 million facility features a zero-depth entry, toddler play area, lily pad water walk, climbing wall, and water slides. Open family swimming is welcome, and structured lessons and water aerobics classes are available. Lifeguards are present, and concessions are provided whenever the pool is open. Arrangements can be made for private pool parties.





DeWitt Dog Park

Located within Westbrook Park, the DeWitt Dog Park opened its gates in 2012 to many wagging tails. Open year-round, this green area provides two acres of fenced-in land for dogs to run free. There are designated areas for both large and small dogs, along with benches for owners to relax.







Disc Golf

Mountain Bike Trail




year universities. More than 40 colleges and universities can be found within a 90-mile radius of DeWitt.







An innovative senior living complex is adding a new dimension to the community. The 95,000-square-foot facility (slated to open in 2022) is located on Maynard Way between Kamper Korner and Kids' Business. The structure also features community spaces where residents and visitors can mingle, and meeting rooms where outside organizations, such as service groups, can meet.



Economic Development



he DeWitt Chamber & Development Company spearheads the efforts in the community's economic development, business growth, and workforce development, building on a strong foundation of excellence and promoting beneficial partnerships. The DCDC works with the City of DeWitt and other local, county, and state organizations to encourage businesses to start, expand, or relocate to our community.

DeWitt boasts a strong and diversified base of employers, featuring a blend of more than 300 unique small businesses and large international companies. Retail shops, restaurants, and service providers can be found throughout the community with a concentration in our vibrant Downtown District and along our 11th Street Corridor.

Manufacturing is DeWitt's largest industry sector. Eighteen manufacturing companies are located in or around the Crossroads Business Park, the city's industrial park on the south edge of town, and the surrounding area. Businesses range from five employees up to 350 employees. Guardian Glass, part of global glass manufacturer Guardian Industries, is DeWitt's largest employer, shipping almost 10,000 truckloads of float glass products every year. Other large manufacturing employers include Car-Freshener Corporation and Custom-Pak.

The premier business park is located next to four-lane Highway 30 and features highly visible properties sized and zoned



uardian Industries was founded in 1932 as Guardian Glass Company. In 1970, Guardian started producing flat glass and opened its first production line in Carleton, Michigan. Guardian Industries has 25 float plants located around the world and employs over 18,000 worldwide.

Guardian Glass DeWitt was built in 1996 and employs over 300 people. The building is 1/2 mile long and 800,000 sg ft and sits on 80 acres. The construction took 1 year to complete from ground breaking to heat up. On average 900 truckloads of glass are shipped from our facility each month.

Guardian's vision is to create value for its customers and society through constant innovation using fewer resources. Guardian is a wholly owned subsidiary of Koch Industries, Inc.

for industrial use. It is a key piece of DeWitt's focus on sustaining a thriving manufacturing community to provide employment and strengthen the local economy. The nearly 1,000 people who work in the industrial park buy goods and services, rent homes, and enjoy recreational amenities in DeWitt.

ing plant that can handle 50 head a day is expected to come online later in 2022. Our agriculture industry within Clinton County is supported by strong local advocacy groups such as County Farm Bureau, County Pork Producers, County Cattleman Association and a multi-County Dairy Association. Our county fair, held annually in DeWitt in July, is a vibrant display of many of these groups, industries and Clinton County's long-standing agriculture heritage.


DeWitt is included in the Quad City Area Laborshed of 743,000+ people. As a rural community of 5,300, it is expected

that many DeWitt residents work outside our community. Unusual to a rural community is the fact that more employees commute into DeWitt for work than those who commute out, with more than 3,000 people working here. This fact illustrates that employment opportunities and employees are available in DeWitt.

Location & Transportation

eWitt is centrally located in eastern Iowa to connect you or vour business to many transportation networks. Whether you need access to major interstates, four-lane highways, commercial air service, barge terminals, and/or rail service. DeWitt is within minutes of each network and can provide easy access to major Midwestern cities and global markets.

Ground

DeWitt lies at the crossroads of fourlane, transnational Highways 61 and 30. Located just 15 minutes north of the Quad Cities and 20 minutes east of Clinton, DeWitt is within 15 minutes of Interstate 80 and minutes from other major interstates and highways. DeWitt is a mere 2.5 hours from Chicago and Des Moines, and within just two to four hours more of such major cities as Minneapolis, St. Louis, Omaha, Kansas City and Milwaukee.

The Crossroads

This historic crossing of two original transnational highways is found at the

intersection of 10th Street and Sixth Avenue, bypassing Lincoln Park in the center of DeWitt. At this intersection, the Lincoln Highway (later Highway 30) and Highway 61 (historically known as the Blues Highway) cross. The notable crossing is marked at this intersection with a crossroads emblem on the roadway, along with a placard that can be found alongside the street in Lincoln Park, at the base of a water tower.

Air

The Quad City International Airport in Moline, Illinois, is about 40 minutes from DeWitt. The airport offers dozens of daily departures with flights on four major airlines with nonstop service to 10 major hubs. Connections to hundreds of domestic and international destinations also are available. It is a U.S. Customs Port of Entry and Foreign Trade Zone 133. DeWitt also is served by seven general aviation airports, including the Clinton Municipal Airport, which is 10 minutes east of DeWitt, and the Davenport Municipal Airport, located 12

minutes south of DeWitt.

Water

Just 30 minutes from DeWitt, the Mississippi River runs through the Quad Cities and Clinton regions and has a minimum 9-foot channel and 10-month navigation season. DeWitt has access to 46 barge terminals, all with direct highway access and three with rail access.

Rail

The Union Pacific Railroad serves the Crossroads Business Park on the south edge of the city. The Lincolnway Railroad, located 10 minutes from DeWitt, provides direct mainline access to Union Pacific Rail from a 1,000-acre Certified Industrial Park. Just 20 minutes away, the Quad Cities region is served by four major freight railroads: Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railway (Class I); Iowa Interstate Railroad (Class II); Dakota, Minnesota & Eastern Railroad, owned by CP Rail (Class I); and Union Pacific.








Houses of Worship

DeWitt: Then & Now

A rich history

DeWitt, Iowa, was founded in 1836 by settlers from the eastern states. DeWitt was named after DeWitt Clinton, the governor of New York from 1817 to 1822. In 1840, a second courthouse was built in DeWitt for Clinton County. DeWitt was the county seat from 1841 to 1869. In 1856, the Chicago, Iowa & Nebraska railroad (now known as the Union Pacific) came to DeWitt. By the 1870s, DeWitt was a thriving, self-sustaining community with numerous hotels, markets, and a variety of shops and services. DeWitt has had a few firsts for the state of Iowa. The first baseball team, the Hawks, was organized in DeWitt in 1860. The first Spear Water Tower was built in 1957. Other interesting historical facts about DeWitt include: The first school was built in 1867 and cost \$25,000 to construct. The Operahouse Theater was built in 1878. The DeWitt Fire Department was organized in 1879. In 1881, the County Fair started as an annual event. In 1952, the hospital in DeWitt opened. DeWitt's past has helped to form a progressive community moving into the future.


House for the broken... home for the healed!
