
















eWitt provides outstanding educational opportunities for all ages, from preschoolers to adults. As a community, we know education comes from many places and is a lifelong journey of learning through new experiences.

Central Community School District provides nearly 1,500 DeWitt, Grand Mound, Low Moor, and Welton students with a rigorous, innovative education. St. Joseph Catholic School, with its 150-year history, offers the freedom to share faith in the context of academics.

Cutting-edge teaching practices, 1:1 computer availability, college credit classes, and award-winning academic and extracurricular programs have caused standardized assessment scores to rise well above national averages. Opportunities for student success are further enhanced by partnerships between the schools and local businesses.

Central's graduation rate stands at a remarkable 99 percent, and 90 percent of graduates further their education. More than 60 post-secondary institutions exist within a 90-mile radius of DeWitt.

Opportunities for educational advancement exist beyond school buildings, too. Within 20 minutes of DeWitt are seven Eastern Iowa Community College sites offering continuing education opportunities and career preparation for area adults. Iowa State University's Extension and Outreach office in DeWitt carries the university's

Recreation in DeWitt is abundant. It is visible in the six parks overflowing with soccer fields, ball diamonds and playground equipment. In Westbrook Park's 100 acres, there are over five miles of 10' wide multi-purpose trails, nearly five miles of single-track mountain bike trails, an 18-hole disc golf course, four ball diamonds, 6.3 acres of soccer fields and even two dog runs.

Exceptional recreational attractions offer a variety of activities. The DeWitt Fitness Center offers 50 exercise classes, such as boot camp, yoga and indoor cycling. Ten different levels of swim classes can be taken at the Aquatic Center, and an 18-hole, 70-par golf course offers an exceptional golfing experience at Springbrook Country Club.

Getting involved is easy. The Parks and Recreation Department offers 20 different organized programs ranging from basketball to Tae Kwon Do. Groups such as the DeWitt Running Club, Disc Golf and Pickleball Leagues have a healthy following and welcome all levels of experience.

Annual race events such as the Skeffington Memorial Race and the First Central Crossroads Triathlon, draw people from all over the region. For the first time this

On a sight-seeing tour through the historic downtown district, visit the Central Community Historical Society & Museum which captures DeWitt's culture and 150 years of history through permanent and rotating displays. Enjoy the 1878 Operahouse Theatre which hosts popular box office movies and the DeWitt Noon Lions Travelogue Series. The Regionalist art of the celebrated DeWitt native, John Bloom, can be admired in a notable life-size mural and several Bloom replications throughout the downtown area.

Adventure north to see the placard marking the historic crossing of the two original transnational highways, giving salute to the city's "Crossroads to Opportunity" slogan. While you are there, visit the relocated and reassembled 1727 German Hausbarn Museum, originally built in Schleswig-Holstein, Germany showcasing the history of migration of Schleswig-Holstein Germans in America and to DeWitt.
