They had heard about the Manufacturing Day & STEM Fest events and Success Roundtables we've been hosting for Central DeWitt, Northeast and Calamus-Wheatland school districts. The conversation lead to additional examples of hands on learning in our community, primarily the Building & Trades Program at Central DeWitt.

Thursday morning at the nearly finished home that nine Central DeWitt Building & Trades students (& their instructor Lonnie Truelsen) have been working on. This program is just one example of how some of our students are learning while doing, outside the traditional classroom. It is providing skills for a lifetime, while also letting these students get a taste for the construction industry. Lt Governor Gregg lead a lively conversation about workforce development, apprenticeships, post secondary education, and giving all students opportunities to explore careers before graduation.

It was an honor to host this legislative visit. We hope to welcome Governor Reynolds and Lt. Governor Gregg again soon!


