

### IowaWorks News



Your local lowa WORKS Center is undergoing exciting changes this summer. Most recently, lowa Workforce Development launched its new lowa WORKS site, an online employment services system. The new site can be accessed at <u>www.lowaWORKS.gov</u>. The updated lowaWORKS site offers a variety of employment resources, tools and services for job seekers, employers and staff members throughout the state of lowa. The state-of-the-art site now features assisted job searches, a resume and letter builder, an individual user portfolio, virtual recruiter and advanced skills matching section. Users can also find and register for upcoming workshops, classes and job fairs. "lowaWORKS is a customer-centric program that makes it easier to navigate our employment services," said Beth Townsend, director of lowa Workforce Development. "Whether you are a job seeker posting a resume or an employer looking for the right candidate, the lowa WORKS system helps connect lowans to opportunities throughout the state." The new system was updated to align with the regulations put in place by the Workforce Innovation Opportunity Act (WIOA). The legislation is designed to strengthen the U.S. public workforce system by helping get job seekers into highquality jobs and careers. For more information about the new

Also new this summer for the lowa WORKS center in Davenport is a big move. On August 1, lowa WORKS opens its new doors at 1801 East Kimberly Road, Suite 1 in Davenport. The new facility offers a larger area for the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act Partners to work together to provide employment services. Those partners include lowa Workforce Development, lowa Vocational Rehabilitation Services, lowa Department for the Blind and lowa Department of Education, Adult Education and Literacy. The partnership supports workforce efforts without duplication. The new location offers a state-of the-art computer area, job fair facilities for employers, more meeting rooms, a larger hands-on skills area and classrooms for workshops.
