Letter from the Executive Director -

As a combined Chamber of Commerce and Economic Development Organization, the DCDC focuses our efforts on supporting existing business, attracting new business and assisting in enhancing the quality of life in our community. I absolutely LOVE that mission; it empowers us to be supportive of so many great community initiatives as well as leading our own program or work.



Last week the DCDC held our annual Year in Review and Member Choice Awards via Zoom due to COVID-19, social distancing recommendations, and in recognition that this event is usually near 150 people! In my comments, I noted that 2019-2020 has been an interesting year, for so many reasons. The first 3 quarters of the fiscal year were a lot of business as usual. The last quarter, well we all know how crazy and unique things have been!

We emailed the attendees our 2019-2020 Annual Report, click here to view it. We've highlighted some of this year's accomplishments that we are proudest of. Some of the numbers decreased from last year due to COVID-19 restrictions on hosting in person events.

What I'm most excited to share is that despite the unique challenges of the last few months, many of these metrics increased! We promoted more community events, welcomed more members, and saw a 450% increase in views of our Employment/Volunteer Opportunities page on our website. The first part of the year we were experiencing record low unemployment numbers. Business was booming and it seemed like everyone was hiring!

This past year we welcomed 19 new members, and saw a 93% retention rate. To me, this really illustrates the broad and ongoing support the DCDC has compared to national average of 87% for chambers our size. Our Board of Directors has chosen to delay asking our membership for renewals until later this summer. We hope that all our 250 members can rebound from the effects of the pandemic, but realistically we know some will be challenged to do so. If financial adversity from the pandemic prevents you from maintaining your DCDC

membership, please contact me to discuss your situation.

COVID-19 Grant and Loan Updates!

EIDL Program Reopened Again

The U.S. Small Business Administration announced they have reopened the Economic Injury Disaster Loan (EIDL) and EIDL Advance program portal to all eligible applicants, including U.S. small businesses and nonprofits. After funds for the program were replenished in April, the SBA limited access to these funds to agricultural businesses, only. We are pleased to announce that they have opened applications back up to other industries in need of relief. 
