I've heard a variety of presentations this month addressing Quality of Life & Quality of Place; Community Happiness; The Importance of



Each speaker shared what they found to be the key factors that indicated success in these areas. Not surprisingly, these indicators include above average high school graduation rates and work force participation; growing (not necessarily higher) household incomes; and high demand for housing with low vacancy rates. Indicators that were a bit of a surprise included the importance of increased social interactions among residents and employees; thriving service and nonprofit organizations; diverse interest groups (fka clubs); new residents as leaders; and a community's willingness to consider and implement new ideas, programs, and ways of doing something.

Community confidence and momentum are important, some even said essential. Personally, my favorite indicator is a community's ability to recognize that it is
